McMan is excited to participate in a new provincial initiative with Children's Services to deliver Therapeutic Foster Care. Therapeutic Foster Caregiving provides supports eight youth with complex needs through a coordinated team-based approach that utilizes Therapeutic Caregivers as a key change agent. Youth will require a high level of support and intervention and will present with unique needs that are better served in a home environment. The youth will benefit from an individualized treatment approach that is trauma informed, rooted in culture and focused on stabilizing the youth and reuniting them with their family, natural supports and / or community.

Under the direction of the Program Supervisor, the Therapeutic Team Lead will be responsible for the supervision and support to the Therapeutic Caregivers and the Family Specialist. This will include coaching, training, crisis management and support, behavior intervention and evaluation of 8-10 homes as well as being the pivotal point person in coordinating wrap around supports for high needs youth. This position plays an integral part in creating and ensuring oversight for the implementation of the youth centered / therapeutic plan and will engage a team of supports who will help execute the plan and agreed upon activities. The TFC Team Lead will be primarily responsible for establishing connections to cultural and community partnerships as well as identifying additional natural supports, family members, Elders, Knowledge keepers, and other key stakeholders that will be helpful in meeting the goals identified.

This position requires flexibility as some evening and possible weekend work is required.

- Diploma/Degree in Human Services
- SAFE certified would be an asset
- Knowledge of the complex needs of the Foster Care System and Trauma based care
- Experience working in foster care or in a family-based setting
- Supervisory experience
- Competency in the areas of assessment, program planning and case management
- Strong writing, organizational, program planning and interpersonal skills
- Valid Driver's license and adequate insurance coverage
- Police check and Child Intervention Record Check (current within six months)
- Fully vaccinated for COVID-19
