



**Wraparound Facilitator - Hope Homes Program**

Based out of the Hope Homes Program, the Wraparound Facilitator will work with individuals within the Homeless Serving System of Care to support them with transition to independence. The Wraparound Facilitator aims to achieve positive outcomes by providing a structured, creative, and individualized team planning process that works on individualized goals over the course of Wraparound. The Wraparound Facilitator will build teams of natural support for the individuals to enhance life domains that may be a barrier to housing permanency.

The successful candidate will receive coaching and training and possess the following:

- Demonstrated skill set in working with individuals experiencing homelessness.
- Understanding of and ability to work with numerous social service systems.
- Knowledge and connection to community and professional resources
- Strong interviewing and facilitation skills
- High Fidelity Wraparound 101 Training and an understanding of family systems theory
- Knowledge of diversity issues around culture, religion, and other orientations
- Ability to work a flexible shift pattern that will include some evening work and occasional weekend work.

- Diploma/Degree in Human Services
- Experience working with children, youth, and families with complex needs.
- Experience and knowledge related to the principles of wraparound.
- Strong writing, organizational, program planning and interpersonal skills.
- Current standard First Aid Certification and Suicide Intervention Training
- Valid Driver's license and adequate insurance coverage
- Current Police and Child Intervention checks (within 6 month)
- Fully vaccinated for COVID19
