



**Youth Worker – Full Time Sleep Overnight
(Sunday – Thursday 11pm to 7am)

Manhattan Place is a community-based group home for youth who are referred through Children's Services. This home provides a safe, stable living environment with individualized support and around the clock care for youth aged 13-17 years. Manhattan Place works closely with youth to strengthen relationships with their families and friends and foster connections in the community.

The Youth Worker is responsible for organizing and coordinating all general aspects of our youth's day to day needs (e.g., house responsibilities, managing a client caseload, setting up case conferences that support the transition plan and ongoing service plan goals of the youth). The Youth Worker supports and supervises the youth to ensure their needs are being met. This position would primarily be a sleep position with the flexibility to be awake during the night as needed, to support youth or staff needs.

Hours of Work: 11pm – 7am Sunday-Thursday (sleep overnight Shift)

The ideal candidate will have:

- Diploma/Degree in Human Services
- 2 to 5 years' experience in working with youth with complex needs in a group care setting
- Knowledge of the Natural Supports Framework, would be an asset
- A good understanding of how trauma, grief and loss can impact identity and connection with natural supports
- Strong problem solving and critical thinking skills
- Strong writing, organizational, program planning and interpersonal skills
- Current standard First Aid Certification and Suicide Intervention Training
- Police check and Child Intervention Record Check (current within six months)
- Valid Driver's license and adequate insurance coverage
- Valid Driver's license and adequate insurance coverage.
